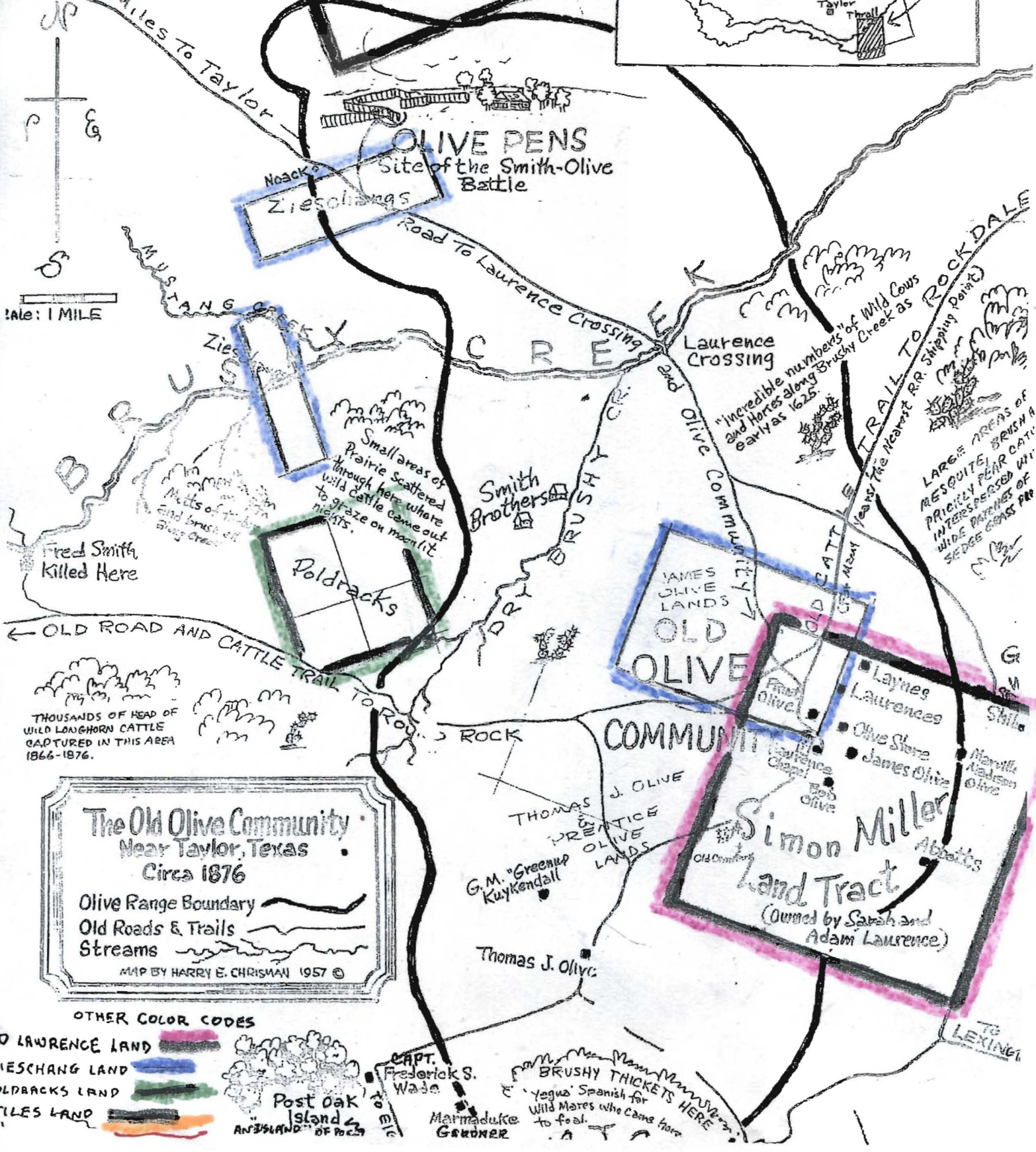
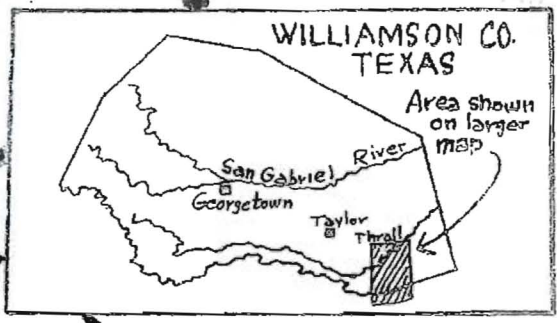


International & Great Northern R.R. "Stiles Siding" THRALL
