

The bronze plaque on the red granite stone reads:

IN GRADEFUL MEMORY
TO THOSE WHO
GAVE THEIR LIVES
IN THE
BATTLE OF BRUSHY
1839

Erected By
Friends and Students
of
Taylor Public School

The stone is located on private property 600 yards from Highway 95 where this marker is proposed to be located. The property owner has an electric fense around his property and does NOT want anyone on his property.
