

Minutes of the Williamson County Historical Commission

A regular meeting of the Williamson County Historical Commission was held on **Thursday, March 13th, 2008** at Mike Fowler's house at 108 W. Live Oak St in Hutto, Texas. Chris Dyer was in the chair and David Hollingsworth was Secretary.
